Community Safety Tip

from the Yarramalong Rural Fire Brigade

The quickest way to get help in the event of a fire is to call 000 immediately. When you call 000, your call will initially be answered by a Telstra Operator, with the question, "Which service do you require, Police, Fire or Ambulance?". When you say Fire, you will be connected to one of four NSW Fire Brigade run Control Centres, which dispatch both NSW Fire Brigade and NSW Rural Fire Service resources. An Operator will take your details and those of the emergency, and it's important you stay on the line and provide as much detail of the emergency as possible including street number, street name, nearest cross street, locality, and relative distances from landmarks. Remember, if calling from a GSM mobile phone 112 can be used as an alternative to 000 if you're outside your provider's coverage area; however 000 should be dialled in the first instance.

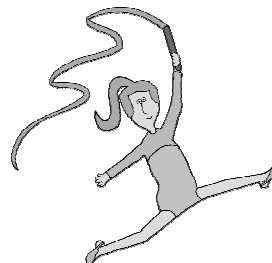
