### Community Safety Tip

*From the Yarramalong Rural Fire Brigade*

Over the cooler months it is important to consider the fire risk of heaters. If you have a fireplace, make sure the chimney is cleaned regularly and the fire place is screened. Make sure you don't leave heaters unattended, particularly when drying clothes. A good rule of thumb is to keep clothes, curtains and other materials at least 1 metre away from any heaters. Remember to regularly clean lint from dryers and test electric blankets before use. It may just save you and your families life. Always call 000 if there is a fire.
