Community Safety Tip

from the Yarramalong Rural Fire Brigade In preparing for bushfire, it's important that your family develops and practices a comprehensive Bush FireWise Action Plan. As part of this plan, you and your family need to decide if anyone will stay and defend your property during a bushfire. In deciding who will stay you should consider that you will need to be both physically and mentally fit, and your property needs to be adequately prepared. As part of this preparation you should put together a home Bushfire Survival Kit including protective natural fibre clothing, gloves, goggles, hat, blankets, towels, first-aid kit, drinking water, portable radio, torches, spare batteries, metal bucket, fire extinguisher, ladder, hoses and a shovel. Remember to always call 000 at the first sign of any fire and to take refuge inside your home if the fire front approaches.
