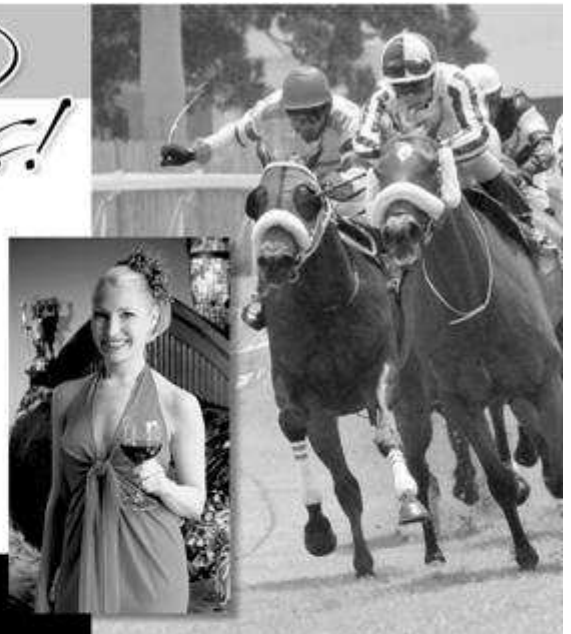

Community Safety Tip

from the Yarramalong Rural Fire Brigade

The Bushfire Danger Period runs over the summer months from October 1st until March 31st, but may vary with weather conditions and between Local Government Areas. During this period, most fires lit in the open require a Fire Safety Permit. All conditions on Fire Safety Permits must be met and Permits are suspended on days of 'VERY HIGH' or 'EXTREME' Fire Danger, and on 'TOTAL FIRE BAN' or 'NO BURN' days. Fires for hazard reduction purposes also require additional environmental approval to conduct, and before you light any fire requiring a Permit, you must give at least 24 hours notice to all adjacent property owners and the Fire Brigade. Small fires lit for heating or cooking purposes do not require a Fire Safety Permit; however any fire that may endanger a building requires a Fire Safety Permit all year round. You must also ensure that small cooking/heating fires are clear by at least two meters of all combustible materials, are supervised by a responsible person, and are completely extinguished before leaving. In the event of a fire, always call 000 immediately.
