## Community Safety Tip

*from the Yarramalong Rural Fire Brigade*

The onset of spring is an important time of the year to begin to prepare your property and family for bushfires. Bushfire hazards around your home can easily be reduced through a number of simple regular measures such as cleaning gutters, removing leaves and dry grass from around and under your home, and pruning and trimming nearby vegetation. It is also important to consider ember proofing your home by fixing broken windows, filling gaps in walls, repairing openings in roof cladding, and installing wire ember screens around and under your home. Remember to store flammable fuels away from your home, to remove flammable materials such as paper and cardboard boxes from around your home, and to direct gas tank relief valves away from your home. In the event of a fire, always call 000 immediately. Plan, Prepare, Survive!




