

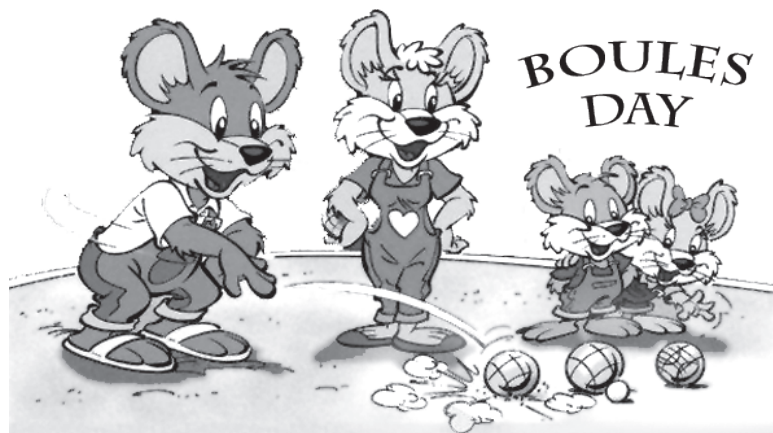

Community Safety Tip from the Yarramalong Rural Fire Brigade

In the event of an emergency, it's vital to remember that the person who may be calling 000 might not be familiar with the emergency number to call to get help or the address of your property, particularly in rural areas. For this reason it's a good idea to write down the emergency number 000 beside the phone, along with your address including nearest cross street. Likewise, it's also important to teach young children the number to call and what to say if there is an emergency. If the person who is calling 000 cannot speak English they can still get help when calling 000 from a fixed phone by saying Police, Fire or Ambulance and not hanging up the phone. Always dial 000 in an emergency and provide as much detail as possible.
