Community Safety Tip

From the Yarramalong Rural Fire Brigade

During the Bush Fire Danger Period from 1st October 2008 till 31st March 2009, Fire Permits are required for most fires lit in the open. Fire Permits are suspended on days of "VERY HIGH" or "EXTREME" Fire Danger and on "TOTAL FIRE BAN" or "NO BURN" days. Before lighting any fire requiring a Permit, you must give at least 24 hours notice to all adjacent land owners and to the Fire Brigade. Additional environmental approvals are also required for fires lit for hazard reduction purposes, but small fires for heating or cooking do not require any consent.
